PROSPECTUS

2008-2009.

1. A Profile of the college:

In the early part of the eightieth decade of the last century the elites of Tingkhong strongly felt for want of a higher educational institution within the vast region of Tingkhong Assembly Constituency. On the consensus of public, therefore, a decision was taken to establish a college at Tingkhong in a meeting held in May, 1972. Accordingly, Tingkhong College (Arts), Tingkhong was established on 1st September, 1972 to cater the need of higher education to the poor students of the region.

2. Location and campus :

The college is located in a vast campus of 45 bighas of land by the side of the Tingkhong-Numrup road 0.75 km. from Tingkhong Oil depot Tiniali with a picturesque surrounding conducive for pursuit of learning.

3. Objective of the college :

The avowed objective of Tingkhong College is to (i) provide higher education to poor rural and tea garden students, specially the girls students and (ii) to spread the light of higher education to the region and thereby to (iii) make the region enable to pace with the progress of time.

4. The College Emblem :

The emblem of the college is adopted on the eve of the Silver Jubilee of the college held in December, 1997. It is a blooming sun

flower with a green leaf over a background of a sunny sky symbolizes the potentialities and aspirations of the rural peasants for light of knowledge and progress.

5. **Affiliation :**

- (i) The Degree stage of the college is affiliated to Dibrugarh University.
- (ii) The Higher Secondary stage of the college is recognised by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council.
- (iii) The college is also registered under U.G.C. section 2(f).

6. **Grade of NAAC = "C+"**

7. **Courses of study and combination of subjects offered :**

The college provides (i) Two year Higher Secondary course and (ii) Three years Degree course in Arts with following combination of subjects.

Higher Secondary course :

Compulsory Subjects : English, MIL (Assamese) and Alternative English.

Elective subjects : Economics, Pol. Science, Sociology, History and Advance Assamese.

Degree Course :

Copulsory Subjects : English, MIL (Assamese) and Alternative English, Advance Assamese.

Elective Subjects : Economics, Political Science, Sociology and History.

Major Subjects : Assamese, Economics, Political Science, History and Sociology.

Career Orientation Course (Self financing) :

The following courses are introduced in the college to develop the aptitudes of the students in their extra curricular aspects and vocational trade. The expenditure incurred in running such courses shall have to be borne by the students themselves.

1. Certificate course in Tea Growing
2. Certificate course in Sericulture
3. Certificate course in Computer Science
4. Certificate course in Women study
5. Certificate course in Child welfare
6. Certificate course in Spoken English.

8. Admission procedure :

(i) Application for admission into different classes should be made in the prescribed application form available in the college office and could be collected along with the prospectus on payment of Rs.50/-only. Admission into the college is made on merit basis. Relevant documents such as marksheet, certificate etc from HSLC.exam.onwards must accompanied the application.

(ii) The last date of submission of form and the date of admission into different classes are fixed as follow :-

(iii) After scrutiny of the applications, the list of selected candidates shall be notified in the notice board of the college and the selected candidates will have to take their admission on the date specified for the purpose.

- (iv) A candidate securing 45% marks in the subject or average 40% in aggregate of all subjects shall be eligible for major course of study. Moreover, a test of 50 marks on the fundamental knowledge of the subject shall be conducted by the deptt. concerned for selection of candidate for major course of study.
- (v) In respect of self-financing course a candidate is allowed to take only one course of study at a time, in addition to his/her regular course of study.

9. Commencement of classes :

- (i) Classes for H.S. 1st Year, H.S. 2nd year, and T.D.C. 1st year shall begin w.e.f. 1st July, 2008.
- (ii) Classes for T.D.C. 2nd and 3rd year shall be commenced from 1st August, 2008

10. Fee structure of the college (Annual) :-

11. Office hours : 10.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. with half an hour break at 1 p.m.
12. Class Hours : 9.15 a.m. to 3.15 p.m. from Monday to Saturday.

13. College Uniform :

for boys : White shirt and black Trousers.

for girls : White blouse, white chador with blue border and brown mekhala or white suredar kutta with blue urna.

14. Identity Card :

An Identity card will be issued to each student after admission on payment of Rs.25/-. A student must carry the card while coming to the college.

15. Attendance in class :

Regular attendance in all classes is compulsory.

- (i) A student must attend not less than 75% of the class held in each subject including the tutorial to be eligible for appearing as regular student in the Degree or Higher Secondary examination.
- ii) A student fail to attend 75% but attends 60% of the class held in each subject shall however be allowed to appear in the examination as a non-collegiate candidate on payment of a fine Rs.500/- in addition to the non-collegiate fee prescribed by the Council/University.
- iii) No student shall, however, be allowed to appear in any examination whose attendance falls below 60% of the class held.
- iv) A student must attend in all seminar and symposium and talk organized by the college.

16. Attendance in college examination :

A student must attend in all terminal and test examination conducted by the college. Failure to attend in such examination, a student shall be declared non-collegiate and as such he/she will have to pay the non-collegiate fine of Rs.500/-.

17. Rules and Regulation :

1. Students must maintain discipline and punctuality in attending college and classes.
2. Students must come to college in full uniform.
3. Students shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner towards both staff (teaching & non teaching) and fellow students.
4. Student shall maintain silence in classroom and desist from demonstration and disorderly behaviour.
5. Student shall take care of college property and must not cause any damage to them.
6. Student shall keep their bicycle, scooters etc. in the shed provided for the purpose.
7. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and any student found indulging in such activities shall strongly be dealt with.
8. Students shall have to take prior permission from the principal for (i) organization of any meeting (ii) invitation of guest to address students and (iii) any kind of notification to be displayed in the notice board of the college.
9. Students shall actively participate in all the functions organized by the college and students union.
10. Students shall keep the campus and the classroom of the college clean and maintain a congenial atmosphere for pursuit of learning.

18. College Library :

The college has a well-stocked library with Text Book, Reference Book, Journals, Periodicals and dailies.

The college library is open from 9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. in all working days of the college. Book lending from the library is guided by the following rules.

(i) No. of book issued to students at a time.

H.S. classes - 2 books

T.D.C.(General) - 2 books

T.D.C.(Major) - 4 books

(ii) A book is lent to student for 7 days only. Failure to return the

book within the period the student will have to pay a fine of Rs.1.50 per day for 15 days and of Rs.5.00 per day thereafter. However on request, the librarian at his/her discretion may renew the issue of a book. But the book must be return within one month from the date of its first issue.

- (iii) Failure to return borrowed book within the month the library card of the student will be withdrawn.
- (iv) In case of loss, damage or misuse of book a student will have to pay double value of the book.

19. Hostel Accommodation :

The college has a girl's Hostel with 20 nos. seat capacity only, Application for Admission in to hostel is to be made to the principal at the time of admission. Seats are allowed to needy students only. Married students are not allowed for hostel seat. Hostel boarders must strictly observe the rules of the hostel prescribed by the college authority.

20. Students' Union of the College :

The college has a student union with a elected executive body. It organize Freshers Social, Annual Sports, Literary, Cultural and debating competitions, thereby open opportunities to students to develop their extra cur-ricular activities and skill. It also publishes its magazine annually in addition to Wall Magazine published from time to time under supervision of a memeber of the teaching staff.

21. N.S.S.:

The college has a unit of National Service Scheme with a volunteer strength of 100 students. This unit of students undertakes varrious scheme of social welfare activities and theirby develops among them the value of discipline, dignity of labour, sense of responsibilty and social conciousness.

22. Scholarship:

The students of college received folowing scholarships:

1. National Merit Scholarship, 2. State Merit Scholarship, 3. SC and ST Scholarship, 4. OBC/MOBC Scholarship, 5. Poor student merit scholarship. (Offerred by teachers unit of the college).

23. Seminar and Annual Lecture:

The college also organized two lectures every year on 1st September on occasion of 'Foundation Day' of the college and 2nd December on the occasion of 'Assam Divas'. Eminent educationalist and scholar will present their talk on the subject specified. Moreover, each deptt. shall organize seminars/symposium from time to time to develop the intellectual pursuit of the students.
