**PROSPECTUS**

**1. A Profile of the College :**

In the early part of the eightieth decade of the last century the elites of Tingkhong strongly felt for want of a higher educational institution within the vast region of Tingkhong Assembly Constituency. On the consensus of Public, therefore, a decision was taken to establish a college at Tingkhong in a meeting held in may 1972. Accordingly Tingkhong College (Arts), Tingkhong was established on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 1972 to cater the need of higher education to the poor students of the region.

**2. Location and Campus:**

The college is located in a vast campus of 45 bighas. of land by the side of the Tingkhong - Numrup Road 0.75 km. from Tingkhong Oil depot Tinali With a picturesque surrounding conducive for pursuit of learning.

**3. Objective of the College :**

The avowed objective of Tingkhong College is to (i) provide higher education to poor, rural and tea garden students, specially the girls students and to (ii) spread the light of higher education to the region and thereby to (iii) make the region enable to pace with the progress of time .

**4. The College Emblem :**

The emblem of the college is adopted on the eve of the Silver Jubilee of the College held in December, 1997. It is a blooming sunflower with two green leaves over a background of a sunny sky symbolizes the potentialities and aspirations of the rural peasants for light of knowledge and progress.

## Admission procedure :

- i. Application for admission into different course/ classes shall be made in the prescribed application form available in the college office and may be collected along with the prospectus on payment of Rs. .50/- only. - v. In respect of Certificate Course a candidate will be allowed to take any one of the following courses at a time, in addition to his/her regular course of study.

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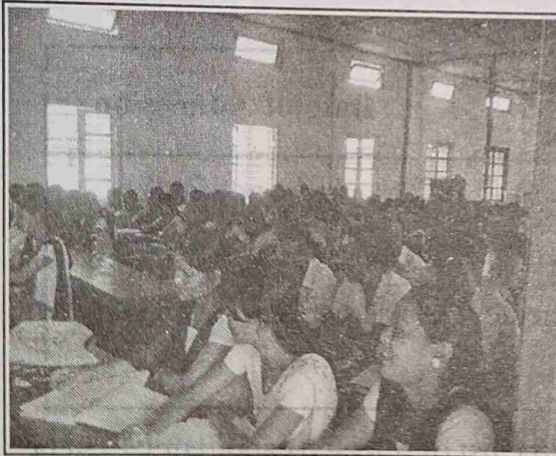

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11. **Office hours :** 10.00.a.m.to 4.30p.m.with half an hour break at 1.00 p.m.

12. **Class Hours :** 9.15a.m.to 4.00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday.

13. **College Uniform :**

*For boys :* White shirt and black Trousers.

*For girls :* White blouse, white chador with blue border and brown Mekhela or white Suridar-Kurta with blue Urna/Dupatta.

14. **Identity Card :**

An Identity card will be issued to each student after admission.

A student must carry the card while coming to the college .

15 . **Attendance in class :**

(A) Regular attendance in all classes is compulsory.

i. A student must attend not less than 80% of the class held in each subject including the tutorial to be eligible for appearing as regular student in the Higher Secondary Examination and Degree Examination.

ii. No student shall, however, be allowed to appear in any examination whose attendance falls below 80% of the class held.

iii. A student must attend in all seminar and symposium and talk organized by the college.

(B) For 1<sup>st</sup> semester student :

A student whose attendance falls short of 80% shall not be permitted to sit in the End-Semester examination of the course.

16. **Attendance in college examination :**

(A) A student must attend in all Terminal and Test Examinations conducted by the college.

(B) For Semester student- A student must attend Sessional Examinations conducted by the Department. Internal Assessment in each course shall be based on sessional Examination/Seminar/Group discussion. There shall be no provision for "repeat" in the Sessional Examination.

17. **Rules and Regulation :**

i. Students must maintain discipline and punctuality in attending college and classes.



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- ii. Students must come to college in full uniform.
- iii. Students shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner towards both staff (teaching & non-teaching) and fellow students.
- iv. Students shall maintain silence in classroom and desist from disorderly behaviour.
- v. Students shall take care of college property and must not cause any damage to them.
- vi. Students shall keep their Bicycle, Scooters etc. in the shed provided for purpose.
- vii. Ragging in any forms is strictly prohibited and any student found indulging in such activities shall strongly be dealt with.
- viii. Students shall have to take prior permission from the principal for (i) Organization of any meeting (ii) Invitation of guest to address students and (iii) any kind of notification to be displayed in the notice board of the college.
- ix. Students shall actively participate in all the functions organized by the college and students' union.
- x. Students shall keep the campus and the classroom of the college clean and maintain a congenial atmosphere for pursuit of learning.

## 18. College Library :

The college has a well-stocked library with Text Book, Reference Book, Journals, Periodicals and Dailies.

The college library is open from 9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. in all working days of the college . Book lending from the library is guided by the following rules.

- ii. A book is lent to students for 7 days only. Failure to return the book within the period the student will have to pay a fine of Rs. 1.50 per day for 15 days and of Rs.5.00 per day thereafter. However on request, the librarian at his/her discretion may renew the issue of a book. But the book must be returned within one month from the date of its first issue.



- iii. Failure to return borrowed book within the month the library card of the student will be withdrawn.
- iv. In case of loss, damage or misuse of book a student will have to pay double value of the book.

**20. Students' Union of the College :**

The college has a students' union with a elected executive body. It organizes Freshers' Social, Annual Sports, Literary, Cultural and Debating competitions and thereby open opportunities to students to develop their extra-curricular activities and skill. It also publishes its Magazine annually in addition to Wall Magazine published from time to time under supervision of a member of the teaching staff.

The College has a unit of National Service Scheme with a volunteer strength of 100 students. This unit of students undertakes various scheme of social welfare activities and there by develops among them the value of discipline, dignity of labour, sense of responsibility and social consciousness.
