1. A Profile of the College :

In the early part of the eighth decade of the last 20th century the people of Tingkhong strongly felt the necessity of a higher educational institution within the vast area of Tingkhong legislative Assembly Coustituency. It was therefore resolved unanimously to start a College at Tingkhong in a meeting held in May 1972. Accordingly, Tingkhong College was established with Arts stream on the 1st of September, 1972 to cater higher education to the needy poor and girl students of the surrounding rural and tea garden areas



2. Location and Campus:

The college is located in a large campus of 45 bighas. of land by the side of the Tingkhong - Numrup Road at a distance of 0.75 km. from Tingkhong Tel Depot Tiniali i.e from Moran Naharkatia PWD Road - with a picturesque surrounding conducive for pursuit of learning.

3. Objective of the College :

The avowed objective of Tingkhong College is (i) to provide higher education to the poor, rural and tea garden students, specially the girl students and (ii) to spread the light of higher education to the region and (iii) thereby to make the region enable to pace with the progress of time .

4. The College Emblem :

The emblem of the college is a blooming sunflower - yellow in colour with two green leaves in a background of a sunny sky. It symbolizes the potentialities and aspirations of the people for the light of knowledge and progress.



5. Affiliation :

- (i) The Degree stage of the college is affiliated to Dibrugarh University.
- (ii) The Higher Secondary stage of the college is recognised by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council.

8. Admission procedure :

i. Application for admission into different course/ classes shall be made in the prescribed application form available in the college office and may be collected along with the prospectus on payment of Rs. 100/- only. Admission into the college is made on merit basis. The application must be accompanied with relevant documents such as marksheet, certificate etc from H.S.L.C. Exam onwards. Student who has passed H.S.S.L.C. (Science/ Commerce/ Arts) may apply for admission into B.A. Programme.

iii. After scrutiny of the applications , the list of selected candidates shall be notified in the notice board of the college and the selected candidates will have to take their admission on the date specified for the purpose.

iv. A candidate securing 50% marks in the subject concerned shall be eligible for major course of study.

v. Selected candidates will have to pay the admission fees through the State Bank of India, Tingkhong Branch.

16 . Attendance in classes :

Regular attendance in all classes is compulsory.

i. A student must attend not less than 80% of the classes held in the subjects including the tutorials to be eligible for appearing as a regular student in the Higher Secondary examinations and Semester Examinations.

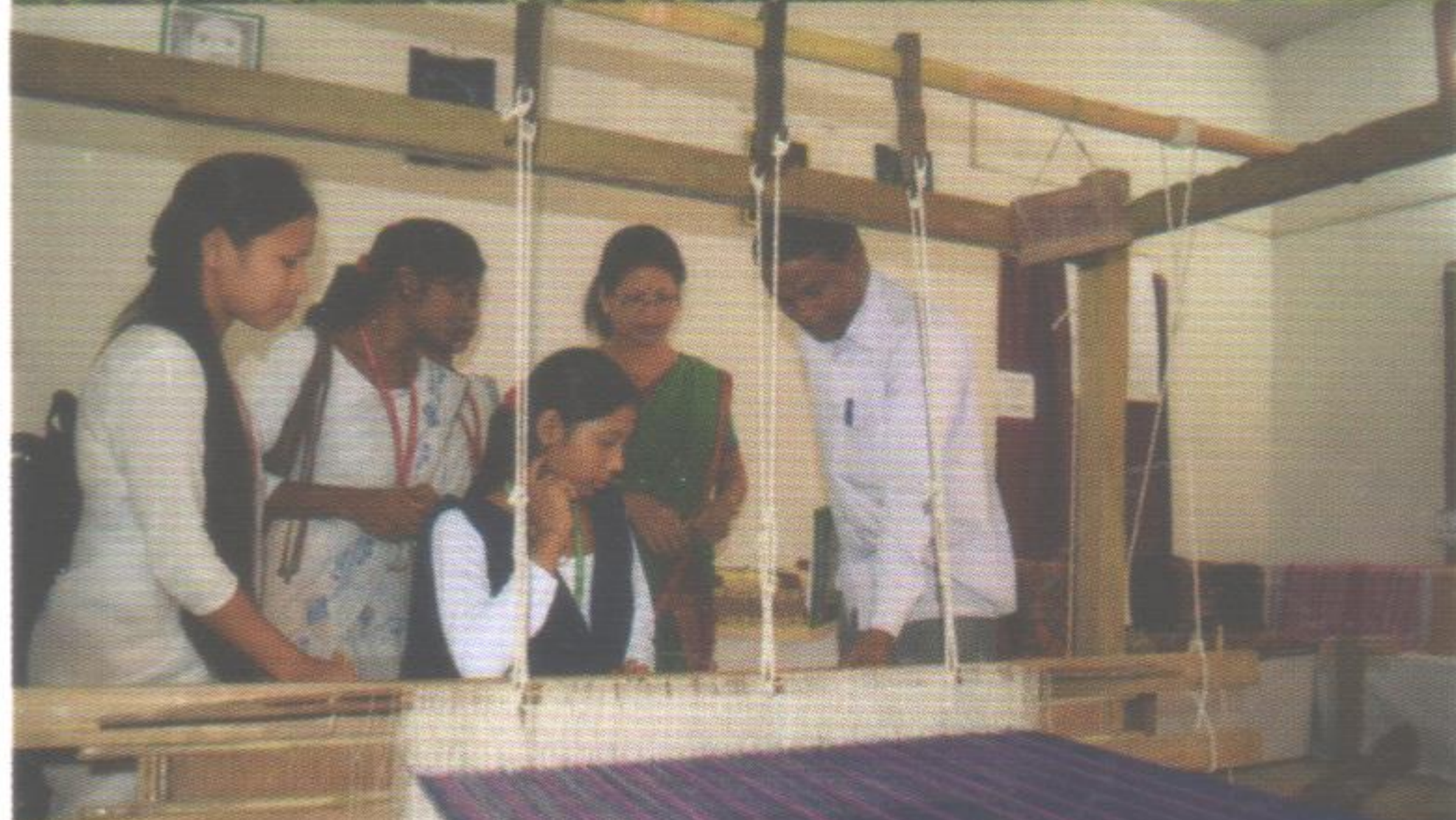
ii. No student shall, however, be allowed to appear in any above mentioned examination whose attendance falls below 80% of the classes held.

iii. A student must attend in all seminars and symposia and talks organized by the college.

17. Attendance in college examinations :

(A) A student must attend in all Terminal and Test Examinations conducted by the college.

(B) A Semester student must attend Sessional Examinations conducted by the Department. Internal assessment in each course shall be based on attendance,assessment of 1st & II nd Sessional examinations and seminar/group discussion.There





shall be no provision for “repeat in the Sessional Examination.

18. Rules and Regulations :

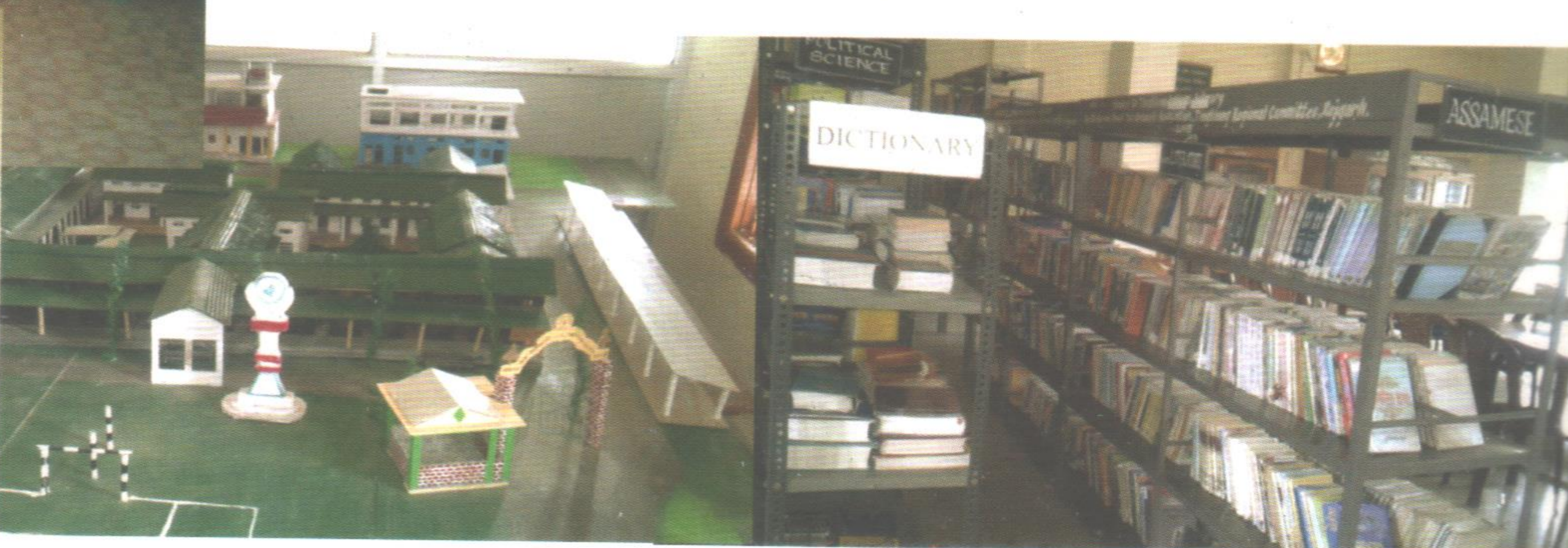
- i. Students must maintain discipline and punctuality in attending college and classes.
- ii. Students must come to college in full uniform.
- iii. Students shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner towards both staff (teaching & non-teaching) and fellow students.
- iv. Students shall maintain silence in classroom and desist from disorderly behaviour.
- v. Students shall take care of college property and must not cause any damage to them.
- vi. Students shall keep their bicycle, scooters etc. in the shed provided for the purpose.

19. College Library :

ii. A book is lent to students for 7 days only. Failure to return the book within the period the student will have to pay a fine of Rs. 1.50 per day for 15 days and of Rs.5.00 per day thereafter. However on request, the librarian at his/her discretion may renew the issue of a book. But the book must be returned within one month from the date of its first issue.

iii. Failure to return borrowed book within the month the library card of the student will be withdrawn.

iv. In case of loss, damage or misuse of book a student will have to pay double value of the book.

20. Students' Union of the College :

The college has a students' union with an elected executive body. It organizes Freshers' Social, Annual Sports, Literary, Cultural and Debating competitions and thereby open opportunities to students to develop their extra-curricular activities and skill. It also publishes its magazine (Tingkhongian) annually in addition to a wall magazine (Matir Swapna) from time to time under supervision of a member of the teaching staff.

The College has a unit of National Service Scheme with a volunteer strength of 100 students. This unit of students undertakes various schemes of social welfare activities and there by develops among them the value of discipline, dignity of labour, sense of responsibility and social consciousness.

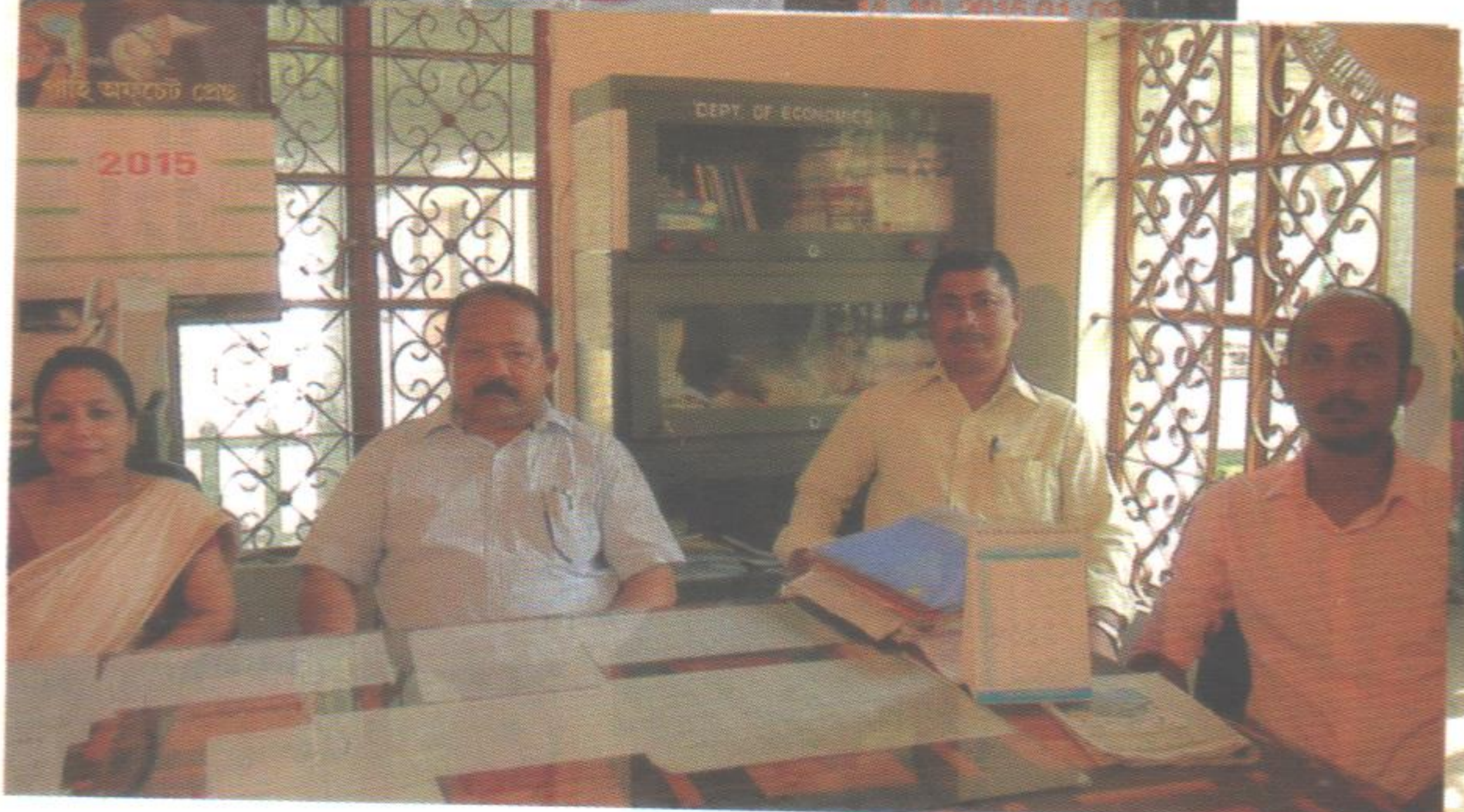
